He gives power to the weak and strength to the powerless. Even youths will become weak and tired, and young men will fall in exhaustion. But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. 2 Corinthians 12:8 & 9 (New International Version)

Darlene Calderon


Read by Schiffon Wong, Burlington Church of Christ, Burlington, MA.
